The route is almost always gloomy and hazy which goes through the foliage of the coniferous and dense forest. The long meandering road is full of loops and curves. The further trek from Lohajung to the Gujreni campsite, which is 6 KM, runs through dark and dumpy forests. The campsite being in the heart of some of the magically panoramic views of snow-capped ranges, it is further surrounded by trees of Oaks and Rhododendrons. Even with so much of geographical curbs, the Brahmatal Trek difficulty level is easy to moderate. In fact, beginners can participate in Brahmatal trekking as much as an expert trekker can.
